About Us

South Shore Sexual Health is a resource centre for all ages that offers services, support, and supplies. We are pro-choice, youth-friendly and 2SLGBTQAIP* positive. We believe that everyone should have access to quality, non-judgmental sexual education and resources that promote human rights.

South Shore Sexual Health is an independent charity run by a volunteer Board of Directors and small staff. Our professional backgrounds include education, counselling, health care, social work, health promotion, and non-profit management.



We began as a \$500 grant project at Second Story Women's Centre in 1988. Planned Parenthood Bridgewater emerged and eventually grew larger, and into its own organization with its own Board of Directors. We shared an office space in Bridgewater until SSWC moved to Lunenburg. Planned Parenthood stayed in Bridgewater due to its central location.

We have changed locations and names through the years. Planned Parenthood Bridgewater became Planned Parenthood Lunenburg County, which then became Sexual Health Centre Lunenburg County. At the time, many organizations were leaving the Planned Parenthood branding behind to emphasize our services were more than just family planning. That's why we're now South Shore Sexual Health!

Sexual Health Nova Scotia is the provincial body of six member-centres throughout the province that are run independently in each of their communities. We are all associates of Action Canada for Sexual Health & Rights, which provides federal support for associates across the country.

We offer guidance and pregnancy options counselling, as well as workshops. Folks can pick up free or low cost safer sex supplies, pregnancy tests, HIV self-tests, menstrual supplies, and genderaffirming gear.

We don't keep any identifying information like your name or age; instead, we write things like "1 call for a Pap test" or "Grade 7 presentation with 24 praticipants". This allows us to see how our services are used without infringing on folks' rights to confidential and secure services.

Our space on 109 Logan Road, Unit 1B gets lots of compliments for being bright and friendly. We have the Transformation Closet, our lending library, lots of free condoms and menstrual supplies, as well as fundraising merchandise like adult toys.

Collab with our Libraries

We are connected with South Shore Public Libraries to help destigmatize our services and bring them to folks all across the South Shore. We partnered with them to do a Transformative Clothing swap during Pride. We also provide regular outreach so folks can connect with us outside the centre.






Last June we attended Social Media Day Halifax to up our marketing game. It's always a great day of learning. We also got to hear from influencer Miss Lion Hunter and more.

We hope you continue to travel with us for the ride! Our community gives us the energy to keep growing.






